TITLE VII. Scholarships

Article 21st. The CIESS scholarships consist of tuition fee, training, accommodation and meal services when academic events take place on site; and they do not include teaching material.

Article 22nd. Full members who are up to date on their fees will be able to enjoy a one hundred per cent (1 of 100%) scholarship and an additional of fifty per cent (1 of 50%) on each of the academic events of the CIESS yearly programme on site.

Article 23rd. Associate and adherent members who are up to date on their fees are entitled to a total of five one hundred per cent (5 of 100%) scholarships and five fifty per cent (5 of 50%) scholarships throughout the CIESS school year on the events of the CIESS yearly programme on site.

Associate and adherent members may elect to use instead of the five fifty per cent (5 of 50%) scholarships, two one hundred per cent (2 of 100%) scholarships and one of fifty per cent (1 of 50%), meaning, a maximum of seven point five (7.5) scholarships.

Related members who are up to date on their fees, in each CIESS school year, are entitled to a total of two one hundred per cent (2 of 100%) scholarships and three fifty per cent (3 of 50%) scholarships at the events in the yearly programme on site.

Related members may choose to use instead of three fifty per cent (3 of 50%) scholarships, a one hundred per cent (1 of 100%) scholarship and one fifty per cent (1 of 50%) scholarship, meaning, a maximum of three one hundred per cent (3 of 100%) scholarships and one of fifty per cent (1 of 50%).

Article 24th. Members who are not up to date on their fees may send participants to academic events paying full amount.

Article 25th. In the case of academic events outside CIESS headquarters, scholarship granting will be according to the agreement entered into with the sponsoring institution.
